Course Content

The standard Dan Grade Theory for Contest Grades

Book-In

9:30am to 10:00am

Everybody should arrive at this time, including those wishing only to sit the exam.

Notes

The course will cover all the techniques required for 1st dan, then the additional techniques for 2nd dan, 3rd dan and 4th dan, including ONE set each of the nage no kata and katame no kata.

Players wanting 5th dan theory must know the entire nage no kata and katame no kata and are advised to attend a full kata course for this. There is a suitable course for this on 4th March at Samurai. All other requirements for 5th dan theory will be covered on this course.

Exams will be for all theory grades up to and including 5th dan. It would be advisable, although not essential, to arrange an uke in advance. Players may be asked in the spirit of judo to uke for other candidates.

Players may only take ONE theory grade on the day and MUST be the grade below the theory they wish to take, including a minimum grade of 1st kyu for 1st dan theory.

Those requiring theory modules towards technical dan grade covering the gokyo or the combinations can take them on this course.

PRIOR ENTRY IS NOT REQUIRED; JUST TURN UP ON THE DAY.

Entry fee: £15 for Course & Exam.

All Players must have an up to date Senior Licence which must be produced on the day.
