This will be an informal course. There will be small group coaching sessions on nage no kata, katame no kata and gonosen no kata, but advice and help on ju no kata, goshin jitsu and kime no kata will also be available during the day for those who have some basic knowledge of these katas.

It would be advisable, although not essential, to come in pairs. Players coming solo may be able to pair up if there are other individuals available.

Entry

Entry fee: £15 for Course

Examinations

Exam fee: £10 (covers all katas)

For Technical dan grade theory: this can be done at the end of the course.

For Club or County Level kata: this can be done only if the candidate had considerable knowledge and ability in the katas before starting the course and only required 'brushing up' and advice on improvement. The senior coach will advise on whether a candidate is ready and his decision is final. Please note that County Level kata certificate holders do not need to take exams for technical dan grade in those katas.
