Same Time and Venue as Junior Referees Course

This course will cover the basics of running a small and medium sized competition for clubs who would like to run events. It will look at the preparation and planning needed, and how the event is run. There will also be sections for coaches on useful information and potential timekeepers and recorders. The course coaches have massive experience in running events at all levels from minimons to major national events such as the Heart Of England.

Please note that this is NOT a table officials qualification course and will not give people the formal qualifications required to be a tournament director.

If the new BJA Tournament Handbook is completed by this time (expected date is April 2010), the course will include an overview of the new handbook, the changes and rationales behind them, and how those changes will affect both event organisers and coaches.

Bring a notebook and Pen (no judogi required). Anybody may sit this course, without a BJA licence. There is no grade requirement; indeed, you don't need to have done judo at all to become a Table Official or event organiser, although familiarity with referees' words and signals will help. This course is ideal for parents as well as coaches.
