Please Note: In High Grades, grades refer to BJA Contest Grades ONLY, also there are no weight categories. However, pools will be drawn by weight, i.e. lightest players in pool 1, next lightest players in pool 2; so players need to weigh in. Pools will be large wherever possible (e.g. 10 players = 2 pools of 5) to give players as many contests as possible.

Open Category

Open categories for male and female players — possibly separated into lighter and heavier sections - will take place, subject to time available, at the end of the event. There will be no extra entry fee.

Notes

All players must possess a valid, in date BJA senior or youth licence or equivalent and must wear white judogi with blue or white belt. Method of competition will be pools, K.O. and repechage; BJA Three Star point scoring Tournament Licence. The organisers will make every effort to ensure that everybody has PLENTY of contests!
